Names of Animals and Birds

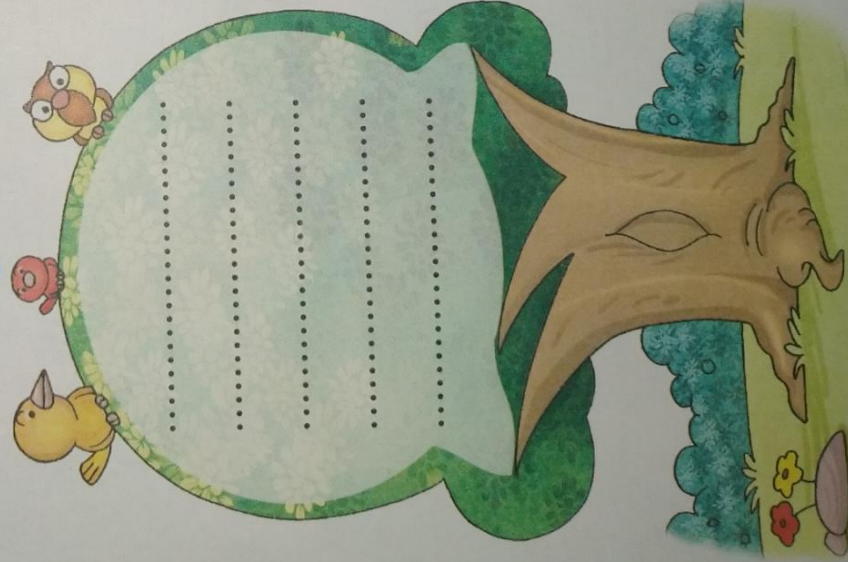


Animals and *birds* are living things like you. They also move around, eat and play. *Animals* and *birds* have names too.

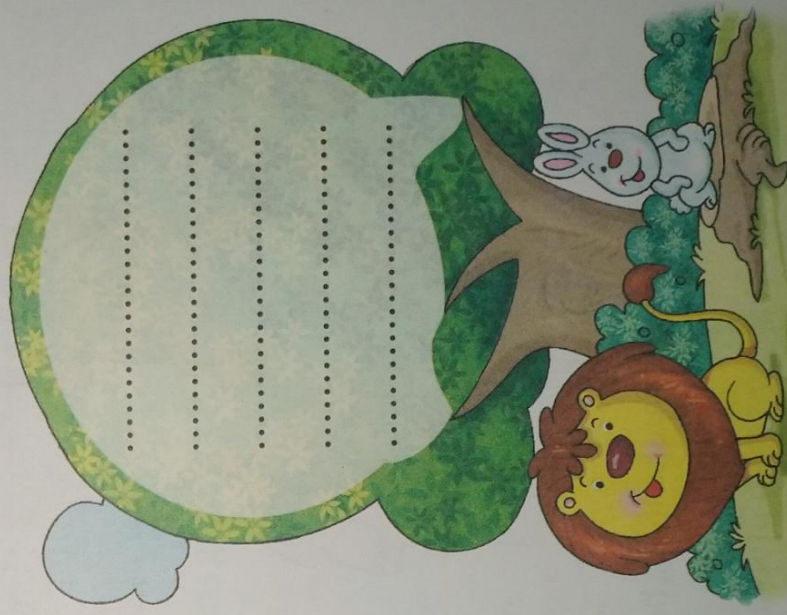

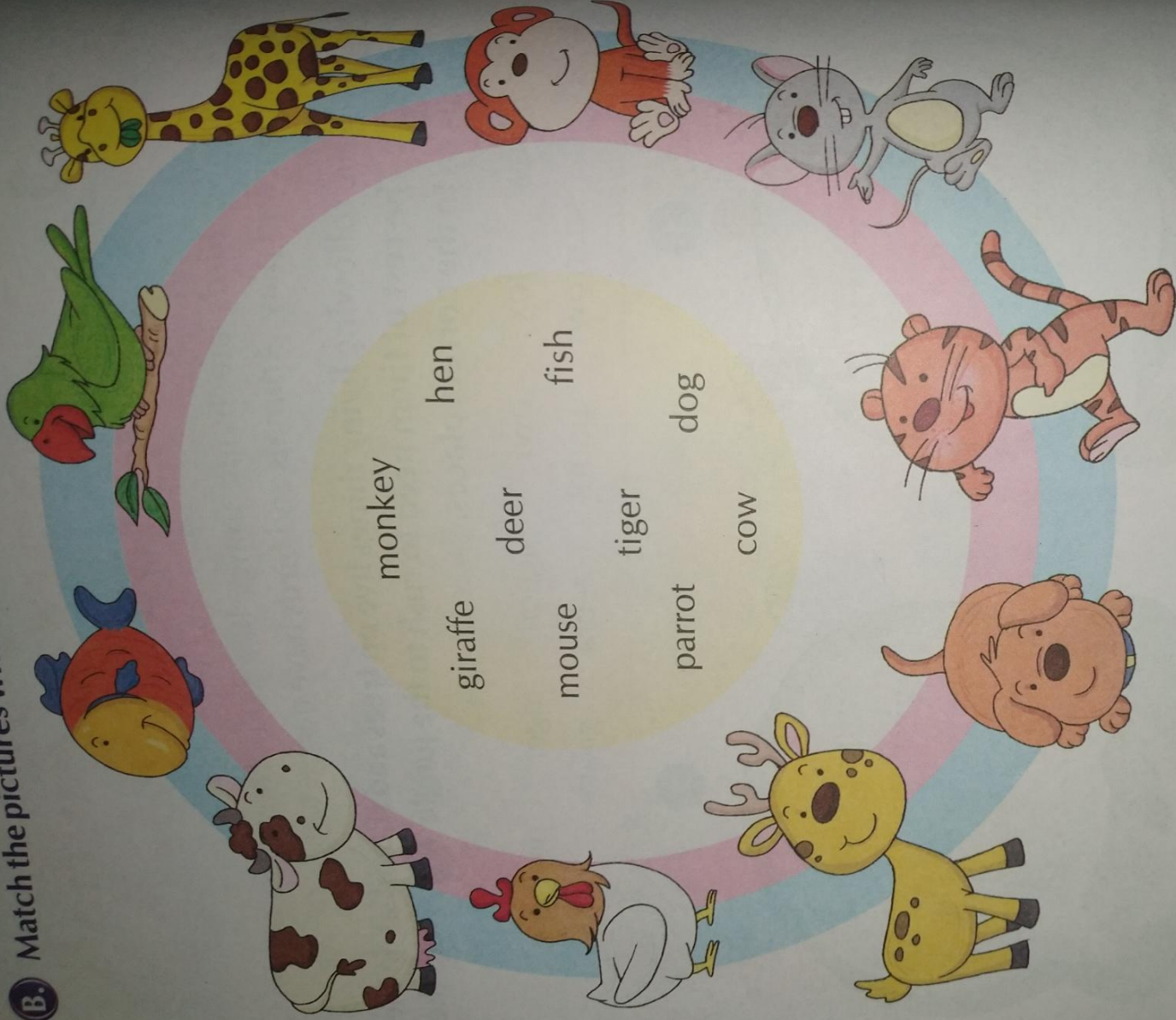
