INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES

Interrogative sentences are those that ask questions and have a question mark at the end.

Examples : (i) Are you going to school?

(ii) Have you met Shashi?

Making questions from statements

Read the following statements.

(i) I am intelligent.

(ii) You have a pencil.

(iii) He is late.

Are you going to school?

Have you met Shashi?

We can turn them into questions in the following manner—

(i) I am intelligent. (STATEMENT)
Am I intelligent ? (QUESTION)

put 'am' at the beginning before the subject 'I'

add question mark

(ii) She was sick. (STATEMENT)
Was she sick ? (QUESTION)

put 'was' before the subject 'she'

add question mark

(iii) He is late. (STATEMENT)
Is he late ? (QUESTION)

put 'is' before the subject 'he'

add question mark

Was she sick?

Is he late?
