**Q1. What activities can blind children do?**

Ans1. Blind children can do activities like-

(a) Reading books, making colourful candles and artificial jewellery and carving wood.

(b) Some children are good at singing and playing musical instruments.

(c) They are able to identify figures by moving their fingers, i.e., by touching.

**Q2. How is a blind person able to read Braille Script?**

Ans2. A blind person is able to read by touching the letters and recognising them with the help of a special script called Braille script.

In Braille script, there are raised dots for all the letters (A, B, C.... X, Y, Z). The shapes of all the letters are formed with 6 raised dots.

**Q3. Why does a person suffer from cerebral palsy?**

Ans3. A person suffers from cerebral palsy because the brain of the person is not well-developed and has no control over the organs of the body. The underdeveloped brain affects body movements and muscle coordination.
