

On holidays, we go for a **picnic**. We play in the open and have a lot of fun.





Recreation keeps us fresh and active.





Our body is a living machine. It has two types of organs—external and internal. Organs are parts of our body. External organs are those that can be seen.



The brain is inside our head. It helps us think, learn and remember. It controls all the organs of the body.








Heart


Keep your hand on the left side of your chest. Do you feel something beating like a drum? Yes, it is your heart. Our heart pumps blood to all parts of the body.
