1. The friendship of Algu and Jumman is being referred to in the given line. They had a strong bonding because whenever either of them went away from the village, the other looked after his family.

Gradually, Jumman grew indifferent towards her and his wife even grudged the little food that she wanted every day. up a separate kitchen but Jumman refused to do so. Then, she decided to take her case to the Panchayat.
