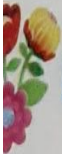

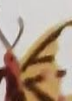

Read and Answer

1. In order to catch the robbers, Tenaliraman asked his wife to spread stories about their wealth.
2. The robber who watched Tenaliraman and his wife hiding the wealth in the well went and informed the chief about the wealth and the place where it was hidden.
3. While the robbers were drawing out water from the well, Tenaliraman made a path for the water to flow towards the plants. He did not let the water go waste; he used it to water the plants instead.
4. When the robbers saw Tenaliraman in front of them, they realised that they had been tricked by him and his wife. It dawned upon them that

there was no wealth inside the well; instead it was a ploy to catch them red-handed. They tried to escape but the Kotwal and his guards nabbed them.

Think and Answer

1. Tenaliraman was clever and smart. He was known for his presence of mind. Therefore, when the Kotwal was worried about the series of robberies, he thought of seeking Tenaliraman's help as he knew that with his clever and witty ideas, Tenaliraman would definitely be able to catch the robbers.
2. Both Tenaliraman and his wife made it sure that the robber watched them dropping the heavy box inside the well as they wanted to trick the robbers into believing that there was wealth hidden in the well. They were sure that on seeing this, the robber would go and inform his chief and, at the opportune time, the robbers would surely come to raid the well.

3. Tenaliraman was indeed clever. In order to catch the robbers, first he made sure that the story about his wealth is spread far and wide. Because of the fake story, one of the robbers got himself hired in his house so that he could spy on them. And this was what Tenaliraman wanted. Finally, he could see that his plan was working and soon he would be able to catch the robbers.
4. The robber said this line as he knew that the wooden box in which Tenaliraman and his wife had hidden the wealth was a heavy one. So, he thought that the wooden box must be at the bottom of the well.
5. In a difficult situation, we should not get scared or angry. We should keep our cool and act wisely.
